Camp Philosophy, Priorities, & Staff

During this camp, we wish to offer a comfortable environment for youth football players in grades 7 & 8 to learn the essential fundamentals of football. All skills will be relevant and crucial to the development of young football athletes. Additional off-the-field training mechanisms will also be provided. This camp is designed to physically & mentally prepare each camper for their upcoming season. The instruction that the campers will receive from the knowledgeable staff at the Midwest Football Academy camp will not only advance these young athletes as football players, but will also provide them with a solid foundation as leaders and teammates. UW Oshkosh Head Football Coach Pat Cerroni & his staff, led by Assistant Head Coach John O'Grady, will oversee & provide instruction during the camp. Each camper will have the opportunity to experience the collegiate level football atmosphere and coaching. This camp will be modeled after the UW Oshkosh Titans pre-season camp in August. Specially selected former & current UW Oshkosh Football Staff, along with additional college coaches, will be on-hand to teach, challenge, & support these young athletes. An excellent coach-to-player ratio is one of the top priorities of this camp.

Focus of Instruction

- Quarterbacks—stance, drops, footwork, delivery, ball handling
- Running Backs—stance, footwork, routes, catching, ball security, blocking
- Wide Receivers/Tight Ends—stance, releases, routes, patterns, catching, blocking
- Linebackers—stance, footwork, hit & shed, pass drops, run stopping (iso-off tackle)
- Defensive Backs—stance, alignment, zone & man technique, coverage, reads
- Defensive Lineman—stance, get-off, blow delivery, alignment, reaction, pursuit, pass rush, agility
- Offensive Lineman—stance, starts, base & reach blocks, 1st & 2nd level pulls, 3 & 5 step pass protection
